Grant eligibility	 The Foundation can only accept applications from organisations that are: Endorsed by the Australian Tax Office as a Deductible Gift Recipient (DGR – Item 1) Registered as a Charity with the Australian Charity and Not for Profit Commission Endorsed by the Australian Tax Office as a Tax Concession Charity (TCC) Auspicing is not desirable, but is considered for international organisations only.
Funding exclusions and limitations	 Individuals Statutory bodies Private schools or universities which are funded at a large scale Sports and leisure (where there isn't a social welfare focus) Capital or endowment funds to fund a chair or provide corpus Auspicing is not permitted (except for International) Applications for projects that have previously been declined by this Foundation Organisations which have not successfully acquitted a grant Political parties or their candidates Promotion of religion
Grant frequency	Annual; multi-year grants will be considered for long-term partners
Grant size	\$60-90,000 single grant
Grant duration	1 year
